



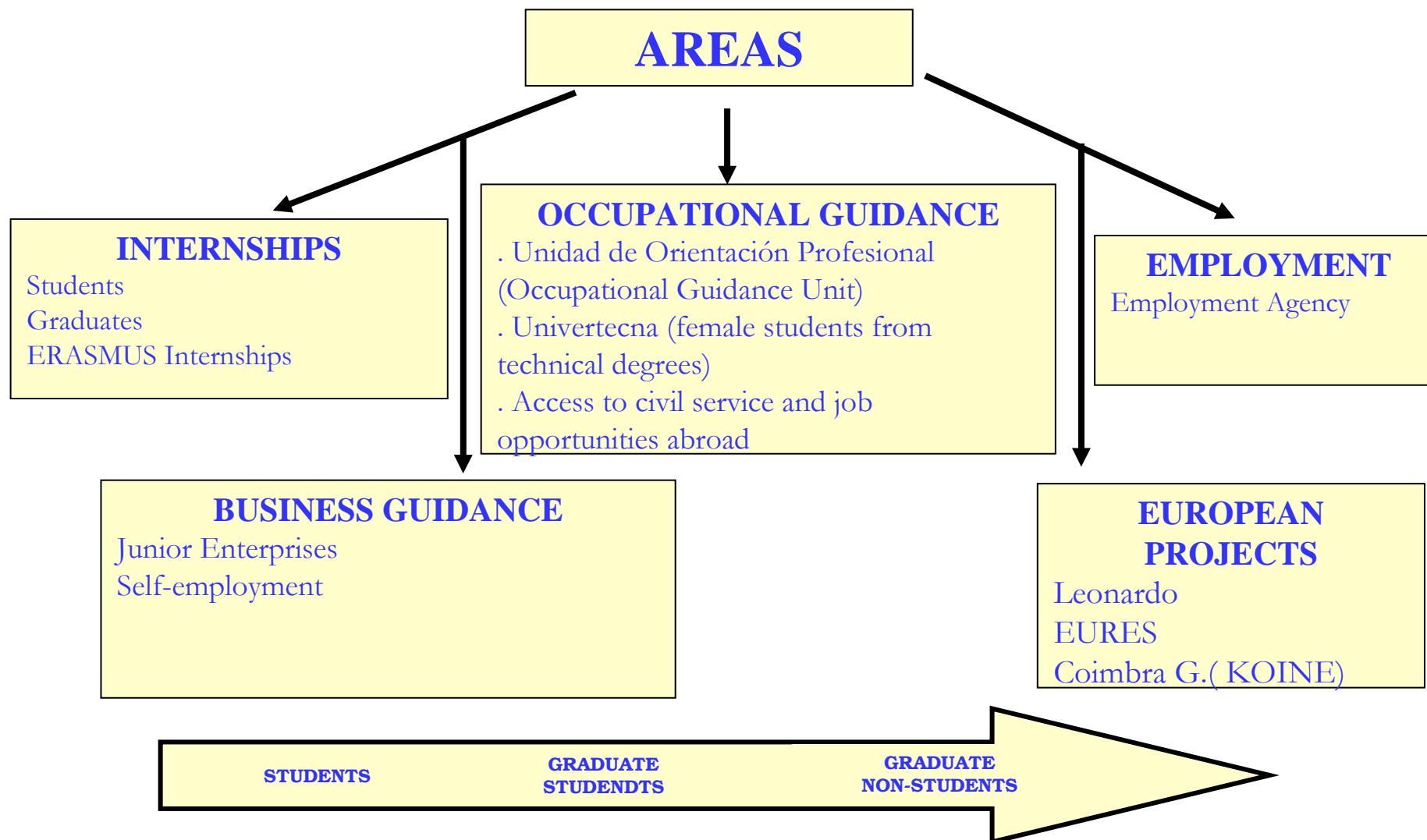

GRANADA

- City and metropolitan area: 500,000 inhabitants
- Three main development engines (City Council, local Banking and University)

Internships

- Academic internship: (necessary to obtain the degree)
 - Non-salaried
 - Tasks and conditions determined by the University
- Professional training: (optional and with the possibility of academic recognition)
 - Managed by us
 - Salaried by host entity
 - Tasks and conditions negotiated between entity and UGR

Professional Training

- *Non Graduates:*
- *External Program:* Funded by host company.
- *Non Profit Entities:* jointly financed (50/50) between host entity and the Andalusian Government (NGOs, and “specials”).
- *Internal training:* At Centres, Departments and Services of the UGR, jointly paid by these bodies and us.
- *Graduates:*
- *Professional Experiences for Employment:* Training for graduates penalized by the labour market. Financed between Andalusian Government and host entities.
- *Leonardo, ERASMUS and bilateral agreements.*
